
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that the Art Grand Steinway piano with the identification number 117239, Model B grand Ivoryized, dull finish, special laquer hardware, inlaid marquetry, SK 47, is the property of the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation. SK 47 represents a sketch number shown to the customer and is probably the number of the special case of this piano.

The piano was shipped by Steinway, through their dealer in Washington, D.C. to Dr. T. M. Murray on November 5, 1905. It subsequently belonged to a sheik in North Africa and returned to the U.S. in the early teens. We do not know more than this of it's history. It was given to the Foundation in the early 1970's and was placed in the Taliesin West living room by Mrs. Frank Lloyd Wright, where it remained until shortly after her death in 1985.

The Foundation has the right to sell the piano and wishes to dispose of it because there is not an appropriate place at Taliesin West to keep it. The Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation is a 501-c-3 organization.



